

- Amanda McPhee and Corrin Conroy shared medalist honors and led Albany to a one-stroke victory at the America East Golf Championship at Simsbury Farms Golf Course in Simsbury, Conn.
- The Great Danes posted a team total of 657 over 36 holes, one shot ahead of runner-up Hartford. Boston University finished third with 687.
- It was the second championship for Albany, which also took home team honors at Blackledge County Club in 2004, the last time the event was held in Connecticut.
- McPhee and Conroy were joined by Hartford's Juliana Carillo at the top of the individual leaderboard. Each of the three shot a 36-hole total of 162 on the 5,826-yard course.
