

## America East Quarterfinals No. 1 Vermont 77, No. 8 New Hampshire 60 Postgame Notes

- Brian Voelkel recorded the first triple double in tournament history, scoring 10 points, grabbing 14 rebounds and handing out 10 assists.
- Vermont improves to 22-9 with the win and has now won 11 straight games and 19 of its last 20.
- New Hampshire ends its season 6-24.
- Vermont improves to 31-26 all time in championship play while New Hampshire falls to 9-32.
- Vermont advances to semifinals for 12th time in the last 13 years and is now 24-8 in championship play over that time.
- Vermont is now 5-0 all-time against UNH in championship play and won 22 of the last 26 meetings between the two teams overall.
- John Becker improved to 6-1 all time in championship play as Vermont head coach, while Bill Herrion, the championship's all-time wins leader among head coaches fell to 21-14.
- New Hampshire jumped out to a 27-19 lead with 7:59 to go by virtue of a 9-0 run.
- Vermont countered with an 18-0 bridging the first and second halves.
- Vermont outrebounded UNH, 40-19, and had 21 second-chance points.
- Patrick Konan led UNH with 19 points.
- Vermont will play the winner of #4 Albany and #5 UMBC in the first men's semifinal Sunday at 5 p.m. at SEFCU Arena.
